- **Organize a Donation Drive** for items on our Wish List – these are items we always are in need of and appreciate donations of, such as treats, toys, cleaning supplies, etc;

- **Organize a Dress Down Day at Work** – Have a “Casual Day” fund for employees to dress down with proceeds donated to Humane Pennsylvania!

- **Use Your Homework to Help Animals** – Learn more about animal welfare issues and spread what you’ve learned by using these topics for research papers, class presentations, etc;
- **Sponsor a Contest** – Use a little competition to spice things up at school, work, community with a prize for the winning group who raises the most donations, money, etc; for the shelter!
- **Organize a Fundraiser** – Penny Drive at school, Neighborhood Pet Wash, Bake Sale, Garage Sale, Cook-Off, Movie Night, etc; with proceeds donated to Humane PA!
- **Organize a Service Day** – Have your community group, business, etc; set up a 1 day Service Day at Humane PA! (Projects typically include yard work or shelter cleaning/organizing projects.)
- **Letter Writing Project** – Show your support for legislation that fights animal cruelty – send a thank you to legislators who support these efforts and contact those who haven’t about why you think they should. Submit editorials in the local paper, write an article in the school newspaper, about animal welfare issues!
